Introduction: Caitlin loved to travel, particularly to places where history happened. She walked the Normandy beaches, slogged through the World War I trenches in Belgium, and trudged in the snow at Auschwitz. She documented every story with her ever-present video camera. Even when she left Veterans Heritage Project for college, she continued to travel—able to brag she had climbed the ruins of Machu Picchu before Mrs. Hatch!

Caitlin, we lost you far too soon. To remember the joy you had for travel, Veterans Heritage Project has created a travel scholarship in your name, with donations from your family and friends. You will always be over our shoulder or in our suitcase, traveling along with us.

PURPOSE: Provide a travel opportunity to a deserving student eager to experience another culture, particularly one associated with military history.

AMOUNT: \$2,000.

WHO MAY APPLY¹

1. Student in an established Veterans Heritage Project chapter.
2. Student with no less than *two years*² active participation in VHP.
3. Student in good standing with chapter advisor, who will review and sign applicant submission.
4. Student with a love for travel.
5. WINNER will be announced at the annual VHP reception in April of 2015.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Fill out application/agreement, (attached) that includes the name of your chapter, advisor, your name, home address, phone number, and social security number (needed if scholarship awarded). This application is also an agreement with terms and conditions, and must be agreed to and signed by the student and, if a still a minor, by their parent/guardian.
2. Explain in 500 words or less where you would travel with this scholarship and how this travel experience would make you a better citizen of America and the world. Please double

¹ Race, religion, gender, or physical disability will neither qualify nor disqualify a student for consideration. Scholarship is awarded for travel only after student has met ALL the criteria listed above.

² Two years includes the first complete year in a VHP chapter and the current year in which the student is active.

space and proofread for errors, which can disqualify your essay. DO NOT SIGN your essay; this will help to assure fair, unbiased review.

3. Submit application and essay by email to brittany@veteransheritage.org no later than March 30, 2015 by 11:59 p.m. Submissions will open on March 5, 2015.

HOW THE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE CHOSEN

1. Submission will be reviewed by three members of the Veterans Heritage Project Board.
2. Selection by the committee will be final.
3. Winner will be notified by email on April 10, 2015.

AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIP³

1. Winner must be present at the annual reception in Phoenix in April 2015, when the scholarship will be presented.
2. Winner will share his/her travel experience with the VHP Board and the Campbell family *in writing* within two months of the travel experience.

Veterans Heritage Project (VHP) Terms and Conditions

- VHP is not responsible for any lost or misdirected entries.
- Only one submission is allowed per Applicant.
- The scholarship award is non-transferable.
- VHP reserves the right to amend or cancel the scholarship program at any time.
- Applications must be submitted and the winner announced before travel begins.
- Retrospective applications are not permitted.
- The value of all scholarships is taxable income to the recipient, and VHP is required to report Jennifer Caitlin Campbell Travel Scholarships to the IRS. Applicants who are awarded a scholarship will receive a Form 1099 reporting the value of the award.
- Any dispute concerning this Application and the Terms and Conditions attached hereto, or any other material concerning the Jennifer Caitlin Campbell Travel Scholarship, will be resolved exclusively by binding arbitration in Arizona pursuant to the then current rules of the American Arbitration Association. Arizona substantive law will apply to all issues concerning any such dispute.

- Before travel begins, the Jennifer Caitlin Campbell Travel Scholarship winner is required to show proof of sufficient travel and medical insurance. Proof of insurance must be in the form of a receipt for the insurance policy outlining the level of coverage, the duration of coverage, the total cost paid, and the name of the policy.
- The Jennifer Caitlin Campbell Travel Scholarship winner is required to submit Proof of Completion for the travel he/she has undertaken. This is due within two weeks of the completion of travel. In addition, the winner is required to write an article about his/her travel experience for inclusion in the VHP newsletter and other publications, within two months of the travel experience.
- Applicant and Applicant's guardians grant VHP permission use of Applicant's name and likeness as it may appear in photographs or videos for promotion of VHP and its mission.
- Applicant owns copyright in all photographs, video, and text created by Applicant. Applicant and Applicant's parent/guardian grant to VHP and VHP-authorized third parties a non-exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable license to use said photographs, video, and text in any media now existing or subsequently developed for the limited use of furthering VHP's mission.
- The Jennifer Caitlin Campbell Travel Scholarship winner must notify VHP in writing if travel plans change in any way from the plans described in the submitted essay. Failure to declare changes will be considered a breach of the conditions of the Jennifer Caitlin Campbell Travel Scholarship and may result in repayment of the scholarship.

I have carefully considered the risk involved and have given consent for myself or my child to participate in the travel. I understand that participation in the travel is entirely voluntary and requires participant to abide by applicable rules and standards of conduct.
